We Are on God's Side

To remind the Israelites that God was always with them, God gave Moses instructions for building a tabernacle or meeting tent, which could be taken down and set up again as the Israelites traveled to Canaan.

The people donated their gold and silver and their skills to make beautiful things for the tabernacle, including a menorah and an incense table. The tabernacle was a place of worship and the ark of the covenant was kept in the holy of holies. The people worshipped God and gave thanks for God's love.
